Professor Eckart Lange is Head of the Department of Landscape at the University of Sheffield. He holds a Dipl.-Ing. in Landscape Planning from the TU Berlin, a Master in Design Studies from Harvard University and a Dr. sc. techn. as well as the Habilitation from ETH Zürich, Department of Civil, Environmental and Geomatic Engineering.

He has published 8 books (1 translated in German/English), 5 special issues: e.g. in internat. refereed journals including *Landscape and Urban Planning* (Elsevier) and *Journal of Environmental Management* (Elsevier) as well as 28 articles in refereed journals, and more than 100 contributions in refereed proceedings, book chapters, invited journal papers and papers in professional journals.

He is a member of the scientific committee of the European Environment Agency and was elected as the first ever Academic Fellow of the Landscape Institute. He is on the editorial boards for *Landscape and Urban Planning* (Elsevier, nr. 1 ranked ISI journal in Urban Studies) as well as *Landscape Journal* (University of Wisconsin Press).

His research focuses on how landscape and environmental planning can influence anthropogenic landscape change, while developing innovative methodologies of how advanced virtual landscape visualizations and modeling can be used to explore human reaction to these changes.
